

FEENEY PARK DISC GOLF COURSE

Feeney Park is a multi-use community park. Please be respectful of other people and give priority to school functions and organized sports. There may be times when it is necessary to skip a hole or number of holes due to sports practices, games or school pick-up and drop-off. Please use good judgment when the park is crowded.

Disc golf is a game that expects high standards of etiquette and courtesy. Among the basic considerations of etiquette are such things as concern for spectators and other players and respect for plant life on the course. These rules have been designed to promote fair play for all disc golfers. Players are expected to apply the rule that most directly addresses the circumstances.

It is each player's responsibility to learn the official rules and etiquette of disc golf.

Player Guidelines:

Disc golf is made possible here in cooperation with Vallecito Union School District and Feeney Park Foundation. VUSD property includes holes 1 through 7.

Please respect the below rules for VUSD property:

- ❖ No Alcohol or Tobacco
- ❖ No Profanity

Player Suggestions:

- ❖ Skip holes in which other park users are at risk of being hit by a disc. **DON'T HIT PEOPLE!**
- ❖ Out-of-Bounds:
 - Holes 1, 2, & 17 play the paved road as a fairway option, but parking zones marked by blue stripes are out-of-bounds.
 - The remainder of the course is played with any and all pavement as out-of-bounds.
 - All terrain beyond fences along the border of the course is out-of-bounds.
- ❖ An arrow is placed at each basket (often on a tree) pointing toward the next tee box.

PDGA rules:

- ❖ All tee shots must be made from designated tee boxes.
- ❖ Subsequent throws must be made with the front foot no closer to the pin than the front edge of the disc in play.
- ❖ To hole out: the thrower must release the disc and it must come to rest supported by the chains and/or the inner cylinder (bottom and inside wall) of the tray. It may be additionally supported by the pole. A disc observed by two or more players of the group or an official to have entered the target below the top of the tray or above the bottom of the chain support is not holed out.
- ❖ Natural obstacles are not to be altered by players to decrease difficulty.
- ❖ Out-of-Bounds:

A player whose disc is considered out-of-bounds shall receive one penalty throw. The player may elect to play from either the previous lie or a lie that is up to 1 meter away from and perpendicular to the point where the disc crossed into out-of-bounds.
